## ENSURING THE SAFE RETURN OF LEARNERS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025

To: Asst. Schools Division Superintendent
Chiefs, CID and SGOD
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

- 1. Consistent with Regional Memorandum No. 635, s. 2024 re: Ensuring the Safe Retrun of Learners for School Year 2024-2025, and to ensure adherence to the MATATAG Education Agenda specifically on taking good care of learners by promoting their well-being and providing a positive learning environment, this Office requests all elementary and secondary schools to follow the guidelines to ensure the safe return of learners for School Year 2024-2025, such as but not limited to:
  - protect learners from abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying, and other forms of abuse by strictly implementing DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 titled DepEd Child Protection Policy;
  - ensure that healthy and nutritious food and beverages are available to learners in compliance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2017 titled Policy and Guidelines on Healthy Food and Beverages Choices in Schools and in DepEd Offices;
  - enjoin compliance with DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2015 titled DepEd Guidelines and Procedures on the Management of Children-at-Risk (CAR) and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL);
  - provide necessary medical assistance and intervention to learners showing signs and symptoms of illnesses and/or sickness, and
  - request assistance from local law enforcement entities to ensure peace and order within the vicinity of the schools.
- 2. Further, schools are encouraged to coordinate with their respective Barangay Captains and Barangay Peacekeeping Action Team (BPAT) in maintaining the peace and order situation during the first few days after the Opening of Classes in anticipation of the influx of the learners and parents in schools.
- 3. All schools are advised to put up the following:
  - help desk to assist late enrollees, and
  - **locator map** to guide parents and learners of their classroom assignments.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
